St. Joseph Catholic School Tuition Assistance by the Numbers

Currently 68% of students at St. Joseph Catholic School receive some form of tuition assistance and come from all sectors of life. In the 2023-24 school year it is anticipated that nearly 70% may qualify given expanded guidelines through the Tuition Assistance Endowment established through the Diocesan Ignite Campaign.

New this year, St. Joseph Catholic School is providing tools to help families plan for tuition. The chart below shows the minimum tuition assistance amount a family can anticipate based on adjusted gross income and household size. Final tuition assistance amounts will be based on demonstrated need and may be greater than the minimum award noted in the chart. Final awards will be determined for enrolled students who have completed the tuition assistance application.

For example a household of five with an adjusted gross income of \$70,000 can anticipate a minimum assistance amount of \$2,000 per student.
